Club Technical Director

ROLE DESCRIPTOR:

The Club Technical Director leads and manages the development of youth players and youth coaches within the Club structure. The Technical Director will create a sustainable football program that provides clear guidance for coaches, in order to help facilitate a quality football experience to support developing players. The Technical Director should therefore have experience in youth coaching, youth development and coach mentoring.

MANDATORY TASKS AND DUTIES:

- Document a Youth Development Plan, which includes yearly training plans (preseason, in-season, off-season, end-of-season) for each age group
- Lead and manage youth programs that reflect the vision and philosophy of the Australian National Football Curriculum
- Guide and mentor youth coaches
- Attend, observe and provide feedback to youth training sessions
- · Attend fixtures to analyse and provide technical feedback to the youth coaches
- Organise regular coach development workshops for the youth coaches
- · Monitor the development of all youth players and liaise with their coaches in all technical aspects
- Conduct individual assessment reports of players (provided to parents)
- Conduct performance review with each Youth coach
- Organise recruitment of players based on FFA Talent ID competency model
- Recommend the most talented players from the Club to the Member Federation Technical Director for supplementary training at a Talent Support Program (TSP)
- Attend workshops organised by the Member Federation Technical Director and Football Federation Australia
- Report as requested by the Member Federation Technical Director

ESSENTIAL SKILLS AND QUALIFICATIONS:

- AFC/FFA C-Licence Qualification (or equivalent)
- Completed 'FFA Talent ID' course (or registered into next available course)
- Experience in the establishment and ongoing management of youth player development programs and mentoring of youth coaches
- Effective communication skills with coaches, youth players and parents/caregivers
- Ability to provide leadership and direction
- Passionate and dedicated to promoting the club to the wider community
